

Workers' Compensation Case Checklist

If you've suffered an injury at work, you may be eligible for workers' compensation from your employer. Answer these questions to help you prepare for a consultation with a workers' compensation lawyer regarding your case.

1. What date did your accident occur?
2. Was your injury the result of a specific incident, or repetitive trauma?
3. Did your injury occur on-site, or off-site while performing company duties?
4. Is this a new injury or is it a recurring injury?
5. Did you report your injury to a supervisor or employer?
6. Do you have a documented report of your injury from your employer?
7. Were there any witnesses when the injury occurred?
8. Have you been evaluated by a medical professional?
9. Are you currently working?
10. Do you have documented examinations or injury reports from a medical professional?
11. Have you begun a treatment plan for your injury?
12. Have you been contacted by a Workers' Compensation insurance adjuster/representative?
